
A prayer for all those affected by coronavirus

Message from Father Gerry

Dear Friends, it is with great joy that, from this weekend, we can begin to welcome each other back to Mass at Our Lady & St Kenelm's, albeit with some restrictions that have already been shared with you. Current Social Distancing regulations dictate that, at present, only 33 may be gathered in our church at any one time. However, I am confident that this number will be increased over the course of the coming weeks and months. To give everyone who wants to, the opportunity to attend Mass this week, I have divided members of our Parish into groups based on the first letter of their surname. Therefore, this week's Masses will be as follows:

Saturday 4th July: Mass at 1.00pm (Surnames A - F)
Sunday 5th July: Mass at 10.00am (Surnames G - L)
Tuesday 7th July: Mass at 7.00pm (Surnames M - R)
Thursday 9th July: Mass at 7.00pm (Surnames S - Z)

The above schedule of Masses will be reversed next week to allow those that cannot attend Mass this weekend to attend the following weekend (July 11th / 12th). Hopefully we will soon be able to abandon these groupings and return to whole Parish gatherings.

Please remember that the Obligation to attend Mass on Sundays remains suspended for the time being. It is most important that we all work together at this time to keep ourselves and each other safe. If you have, or think you may have, symptoms of Coronavirus you **MUST NOT** come to Mass. If you are classed as being vulnerable in any way, if anyone with whom you live is vulnerable, or you are anxious or afraid of coming to Mass, please STAY AT HOME. These days will pass but, until they do, let's all do everything we can to send this virus on its way. Keep washing your hands, maintain Social Distancing when out and about, wear a mask in crowded places, but keep smiling! See you all soon. Fr Gerry x
