Sunday Readings Reflection

Readings: Amos 7:12-15; Psalm 85; Ephesians 1:2-14; Mark 6:7-13 The liturgy of this Fifteenth Sunday is shot through with the mysterious reality of divine election. No one is a prophet, an apostle or even a Christian by his own initiative. Whether or not he or she is aware of it, God "chose each one of us in Christ before the world began". Our Christian vocation, whether considered as a common call to holiness or in the specific details of each one's individual path, is entirely his initiative (Readings). To hear his voice and follow him is a gift of the Father (Opening Prayer) and a sign of eternal predestination to happiness with him (Alleluia), and at the same time it commits us to accept, in this life, to follow his same path, suffer the same hardships, carry out the same mission and "reject whatever is contrary to the gospel" (Opening Prayer, Gospel; Luke 9:57).

Urgent SVP Appeal

Can you pledge support to the Parish SVP to help a needy Dudley couple please? *Mike Weaver OLSK SVP President writes....*During the COVID epidemic, the Dudley Council for Voluntary Services has

referred folks that need befriending to Jane and David Clarke who have responded on behalf of the SVP.
"D" is 79 and has multiple health issues. His wife "S" is 63 and moved to

is 79 and has multiple health issues. His wife "S" is 63 and moved to the UK from the Philippines in 2006. The couple have been married for 14 years. S is D's main carer. Every 3 years S is required to renew her Residency Visa allowing her to remain in the UK. The costs of obtaining the visa from the Home office, the Immigration Health Surcharge and legal fees are over £3,700 which are normally met by S from what she can save from her work. Her ability to work and save has been greatly reduced by COVID and there is still a funding gap of over £3,000. She will have to return to the Philippines if she is not allowed to stay. Without his wife, who is his carer, D will need residential care. We are trying to raise funds from neighbouring SVP parish groups, SVP nationally and other legal charities. Might you have been to plad an approximation to the SVP. and other local charities. Might you be able to pledge a contribution to the SVP to help this couple please?
